



11,000 Free Cows and Buffaloes for Widowed and Divorced Women in 2025

Eligibility Criteria for 11,000 Free Cows and Buffaloes;

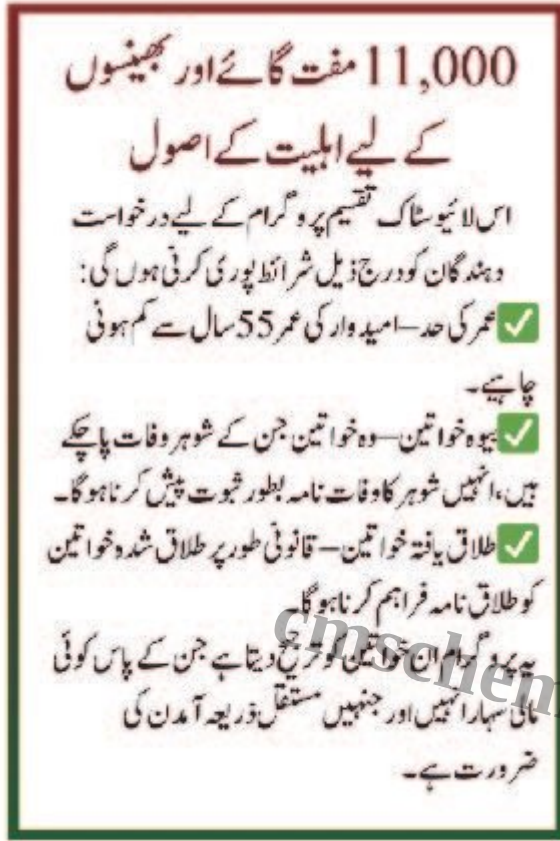
To qualify for this program, applicants must meet the following conditions:
