After registration, the government gives some money to the parents every three months, so that they can meet the expenses of their children's education, copies, books, uniforms and fees. This program is designed to provide education to children and provide financial support to the family.

Eligibility Requirements for Child Registration

To register your child under BISP 8171, you must meet the following conditions:

- Must already be a registered BISP beneficiary (mother or guardian).
- The child must be between 4 and 12 years old.
- The child should be enrolled in a school.
- CNIC of the mother must be valid and updated.
- B-Form of the child is required from NADRA.

Step-by-Step Process for BISP 8171 Child Registration

- Visit the nearest BISP office with:
 - CNIC of the mother
 - B-Form of the child
 - Fill out the child registration form provided by BISP.
 - Provide proof of school enrollment, like a school certificate or admission slip.
- Verification by BISP staff will be completed within a few days.
- Once approved, the child will start receiving payments under the Benazir Taleemi Wazaif.

Required Documents for BISP Child Registration

Here is a list of documents you must bring:

- Mother's original CNIC
- Child's B-Form (issued by NADRA)
- School admission slip or certificate
- Passport-size photo (if required by the office)

How to Register Your Child in BISP or Ehsaas Program

If you want to register your child in the BISP or Ehsaas program, then first of all you should visit the nearest BISP Tehsil Office or Ehsaas Center in your area. The staff there are very helpful. They will talk to you politely and explain the entire process of how to register your child. If you have the necessary documents like a mother's ID card and child's birth certificate, then your work will become even easier.

The people sitting there will also help you fill the forms and will answer every question simply. There is no fee charged in this process, so no one needs to pay any money.

How to Update Child Information in BISP

If you have not registered your child before, or your child's school or address has changed, you should visit the BISP office as soon as possible. You can update your information there.

BISP staff will help you with how to easily change your address or school name. It is very important that you keep your information accurate and up-to-date so that you can continue to receive BISP benefits. You will need to bring your ID card and the necessary documents about your child to update. This is all free of charge, do not take or give money from anyone.

This guide is especially for new families who are registering their children for the first time.

The registration process is very easy, you will not have much difficulty.

After registering the child, they continue to receive regular financial support for their school education.

The financial support is for the children's school fees, books and other educational needs.

To register, you will have to visit your nearest BISP office or Ehsaas Center.

The staff there will guide you at every step and help you fill out the form.

You will have to carry your ID card and necessary documents about your child.

This registration and financial support process is completely free, do not take or give money from anyone.

If you have any questions, feel free to ask the staff, they are ready to help.
