Description

Family Registration Certificate is a new process started by the **government** under which we can **register** the data of our family members in **NADRA**, Family Registration Certificate under which if we want to go **outside our country** or to any country in the **embassy**, our data will be **updated**, which will be our **legal documents**, it will be helpful for us, under which we will not have to face any **difficulties** in going inside or **outside our country**.

Family Registration Certificate Types of FRC:

Step	Description
Provide Family Details	You must provide the details of your parents and siblings by birth.
Include Children's Info	If married, you must also include the details of your children.
Adoptive Parents	Adoptive parents must include the details of the adopted children.

Step	Description
Family Member Registration	All family members must be registered individually for FRC eligibility.
13-Digit ID Card	Every family member must have a 13-digit ID card number.
Unregistered Members	Unregistered family members will not appear in the FRC.
Submit ID Card	Each member must submit their ID card information to be included in the FRC.

Apply for a family registration certificate

Method 1: Visit the NADRA Registration Center

- Go to your nearest NADRA registration center.
- Register yourself directly at the center.

Method 2: Family Registration Certificate (FRC) via Office Visit

- Visit the Family Registration Certificate (FRC) office.
- Get a **token**.
- A **photograph** of adults will be taken.
- Enter your data** and get it **verified**.
- Your **record will be printed** and issued.

Method 3: FRC via Marriage

- If your children are **below 18**, they **must be physically present**.
- Get a **token**, take a **photograph**, enter and verify **data**, receive a **printout**.
- If children are **18 or older**, their **data will be registered and verified** before issuance.

Method 4: FRC via Adoption

- Adopted child must be **less than 1 year old**.
- Get a **token**, take the **child's photo**, enter and verify **data**, receive a **printout**.

Method 5: Pak CNIC Mobile App

- Download and use the **Pak CNIC Mobile App**.
- Register and receive your **digital FRC copy via email**.
- This is a **simple and convenient method** without visiting the office.

Family Registration Certificate Need of documents

Family Registration Certificate for siblings by gender

It is necessary to have a valid identity card.

Your name must match the official record in NADRA.

Photographs of children under the age of 18 are required in the family record.

Individuals who are not registered or have incomplete records will not appear in the Family Registration Certificate.

To be included in the certificate, such individuals must first update their identity card.

If there is a POC (Pakistan Origin Card) holder in the family, they must also register themselves.

POC holders should include other family members in the registration as well.

- **Family Registration Certificate: Spouse and children through marriage.**

Children must have a 13-digit ID card number.

The name must match the NADRA records.

Children under 18 years of age in the Khan family must have their photographs recorded in NADRA.

Only individuals recorded in NADRA will be included in the Family Registration Certificate.

If any family member is a POC (Pakistan Origin Card) holder, it is mandatory to get them registered.

Relatives of the POC holder should also be included in the registration.

Note:

The Family Registration Certificate (FRC) is provided in **PDF format**, which you can **print later**.

Your **name in English can be corrected**, but **name changes are not allowed**.

You can **apply online** for more details and convenience.

The **Pak CNIC mobile app** can also be used to apply.

Alternatively, you can visit the **nearest NADRA office** or **FRC center** to apply in person.

If your **name** in **English** is incorrect, it can be **corrected**; however, the actual **name cannot be changed**. You should ensure your details are accurate in NADRA's system to avoid complications.
