Peshawar BRT: A step towards better travel convenience

How was the decision to expand the BRT taken?

The decision was taken in a meeting chaired by **Chief Minister Ali Amin Gandapur**, which was attended by **senior officials** of various **government agencies**.

Inclusion of more buses

- **72 diesel-hybrid** buses will be purchased.
- These buses are being added keeping in mind the increasing number of passengers.
- A deadline has been set for the purchase of these buses and completion of the **civil work** of the new routes within **six months**.

BRT Commercial Plaza Project

- The commercial plazas under construction in the **Mall of Hayatabad** and **Dabgari** will be completed by **April**.
- The establishment of these plazas will provide more convenience and income to the **Peshawar BRT System**

Steps to solve traffic problems

- Funds have been allocated for the early completion of the incomplete section of the Ring Road.
- **7 new underpasses** will be constructed on **University Road** and **Ring Road**.
- Instructions have been issued to remove obstacles to improve traffic flow on **University Road**.
- A direct road will be built from the industrial estate to the **Northern Bypass**.

Environmental importance of BRT

- The **Chief Minister** said that **Peshawar BRT System** is not only a modern transport project but is also playing an important role in reducing air pollution.
- **BRT** will be further improved for the convenience of the public.

Expansion of BRT in other cities

- Plans have been made to start **Peshawar BRT System style bus** service in four other cities of **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**.
- These cities include **Mardan, Swat, Abbottabad**, and **Dera Ismail Khan**.
- Initially, the feasibility study will be completed within a month.
